





Google Classroom

Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to post assignments, homework, due dates, and much more with students AND parents!




Logging Into Google Classroom

We have a Google Classroom this term. The easiest way to access it from home is to have your child open it up for you on their Chromebook or ipad. They will need to be logged in with their school account.

If you are using your own computer:

- 1. Open the Google Chrome Browser
- 2. Type <u>www.google.com</u>
- 3. Click on **SIGN IN** in the upper right hand corner of the browser window. If you are logged in as a parent then add a person.





Logging Into Con't

- 4. Type in your child's Google Email address (it looks like this: xxxxxxxx@school.ecsd.net
 Replace the X's with the students 7 digit ID number) and press "next".
- 5. Type in the student PASSWORD & click "next." The password is unique to each child.

Now you will see that the student is signed in to their Google Apps for Education account!



What if my child is ill?




