



- Assessment and Reporting Power Teacher Pro a great tool for older learners (grade 7-12). It is not ideal for Elementary Level - looking at changing that platform. More info to come. Bringing back Parent Teacher Interviews in November - demo of learning will be later in the year.

- St. Paul Social Justice St. Francis of Assisi cereal drive. Mrs. Carr-Jeske delivered the cereal this week. A breakfast program is offered at St. Francis of Assisi School. The principal at the school was very grateful thank you to all who contributed
