Request to also include a midyear touchpoint. Google Classroom is a great resource to see what students are working on.
- GATE program structure: adjusted from a pull out model to a push in strategy. Challenges
 with Grade 1 leaving their class to attend GATE 2/3 class. This was happening to help prepare
 grade 1 for GATE program but program has been adjusted to provide a more fixed structure
 for social development skill.
- School Feedback: question raised around how the school receives feedback. No formal tool is in place today.
- Assessment Tool: is there an opportunity for the school to offer more assessment based communications (thumbs up, down, sideways) to better understand if students are hitting the mark or require additional development. To be discussed at the next staff meeting.
