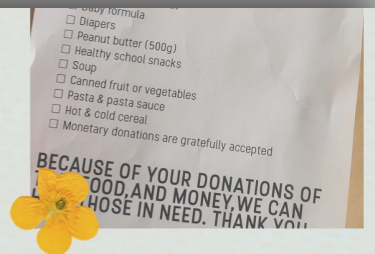

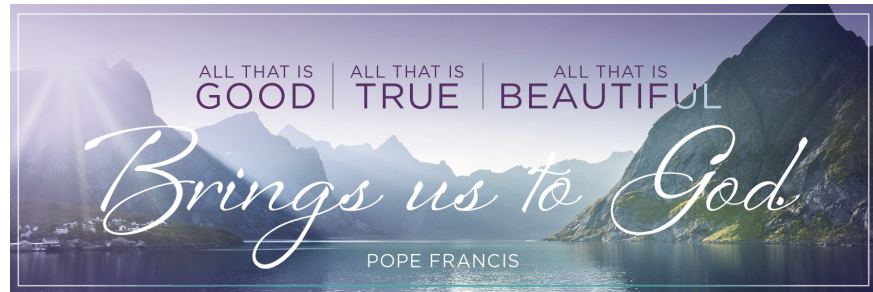
Principal's Message
